- Larrey's pioneering work on medical "triage," will be applied to examination of the overriding population sources of contemporary Jew-hatred as revealed by two decades of Anti-Defamation League (ADL) survey data tabulating extreme Antisemitism, worldwide.
- Additional, independent validating data will also be reviewed
- Potential theological drivers of this Antisemitism will be introduced in relation to the October 7, 2023, carnage in southern Israel, and the explosion of Antisemitic expressions and attacks since that event.

Background 1: The Jihad Carnage of October 7, 2023

- An unprovoked jihadist attack by Hamas (joined by local Gazan Muslims) in southern Israel, during an ostensible "truce," which had been planned since 2014, by Hamas leadership
- Largest single day casualty toll for Jews since The Holocaust, ~1200 murdered
- Targets, disproportionately (i.e., ~70% to 90%), were non-combatant children, women, men, & the elderly
- Atrocities committed against these overwhelmingly non-combatant Israelis included mutilation, torture, beheadings, & mass rape, followed by burning, with documentation by the jihadists own videos, passive surveillance videos, surviving eyewitness testimony, & forensic pathology evidence

"[H]ighest number of incidents during any two-month period since ADL began tracking in 1979, according to preliminary data released today (12/11/23)."

"Between Oct. 7 and Dec. 7, ADL recorded a total of **2,031 antisemitic incidents**, up from 465 incidents during the same period in 2022, **representing a 337-percent increase year-over-year**. This includes **40 incidents of physical assault**, 337 incidents of vandalism, 749 incidents of verbal or written harassment and 905 rallies including antisemitic rhetoric, expressions of support for terrorism against the state of Israel and/or anti-Zionism. On average, over the 61 days from 10/7/23/ to 12/11/23, Jews in America experienced **nearly 34 antisemitic incidents per day.**"

"[D]ata includes **one fatality** that occurred at an anti-Israel protest in Los Angeles, where a Jewish man was killed after being hit in the head by a pro-Palestinian protester.* There were about **250 antisemitic incidents** that specifically targeted Jewish institutions such as synagogues and campus Hillels. **On college and university campuses, ADL recorded a total of 400 antisemitic incidents, compared to only 33 incidents during the same period in 2022**. Overall, at least **1,411 of the total incidents could be clearly linked to the Israel-Hamas war.**"

In the discourse surrounding the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, extreme criticisms of Israel (e.g., Israel is an apartheid state, the Israel Defense Forces deliberately target Palestinian civilians), coupled with extreme policy proposals (e.g., boycott of Israeli academics and institutions, divest from companies doing business with Israel), have sparked counterclaims that such criticisms are anti-Semitic (for only Israel is singled out). The research in this article shines a different, statistical light on this question: based on a survey of 500 citizens in each of 10 European countries, the authors ask whether those individuals with extreme anti-Israel views are more likely to be anti-Semitic. Even after controlling for numerous potentially confounding factors, they find that anti-Israel sentiment consistently predicts the probability that an individual is anti-Semitic, with the likelihood of measured anti-Semitism increasing with the extent of anti-Israel sentiment observed.



 <u>Muslims (with the exception of 60% Muslim majority, Lebanon)</u>— ADL's Eileen Hershenov, Senior VP for Policy, had the temerity to portray, the virulently Antisemitic Muslim denizens of these countries, <u>as follows</u>: "One of the witnesses (Klein) talked about global attitudes that we look at...and the ADL does track that...[V]ulnerable, marginalized communities have bigotry within them."
 - ADL CEO Jonathan Greenblatt "confessional" during 2021 Hamas-Israel Gaza hostilities, which spawned an outbreak of Jew-Hate within the U.S.: "Well, let's be clear. None of the people committing these crimes [were] wearing MAGA hats, right?... we have people waving Palestinian flags & then beating Jewish people."

Independent Findings Corroborating ADL's Data, But Examining Antisemitic Violence & Violent Threats, Across Europe

Gross 2.2-fold excess occurrence of non-lethal violence, or violent threats against Western European Jews, by Muslims, relative to non-Muslims, collectively, who held designated, "right-wing", "left-wing", or "Christian extremist" views, as identified by their Jewish victims.



Disproportionate Antisemitism Among Canadian Muslims (I)

Representative Canadian sample of 1121 non-Jewish adults, 1010 non-Jewish university students, 312 Muslim adults, 414 Jewish adults (total n=2857), surveyed during February 2024.

• 48% of Muslim Canadian adults with an opinion <u>agree</u> that "Jewish people are largely to blame for the negative consequences of globalization," vs. 5% of Canadian non-Jews

 Regarding the statement that "Jewish people have too much power in our country today," for those with an opinion, 83% of Canadian non-Jews <u>disagree</u> with that statement, vs. just 34% of Muslim Canadian adults, a 49%-point difference

• 42% of Canadian Muslims who offer an opinion feel homicide bombing targeting Israeli civilians is "justified," vs. 12% of Canadian non-Jews

 52% of Canadian Muslims who offer an opinion do not believe Jews are entitled to a state in Israel, vs. 14% of Canadian non-Jews




Figure 2.2 Mean attitudes of five non-Jewish Canadian groups toward Jews

Academic Study During Spring 2024: Disproportionate Extreme Muslim Antisemitism on U.S. Campuses

During the spring 2024 semester, <u>survey data</u> were collected from <u>4,123</u> undergraduate students (including 313 Jewish students) at 60 U.S. colleges and universities (public and private; geographically varied) with sizable Jewish student populations. The non-Jewish respondents (3810) were asked whether they agreed or disagreed with nine unquestionably negative statements about Jews and Israel (very similar to the ADL survey questions), & the pattern of their responses was then <u>evaluated</u>.

Conclusions

- Although "a climate of universal anti-Jewish hatred" did not exist, Jewish student concerns about antisemitism were justified, and "driven by about a third of students who held distinct patterns of beliefs about Jews and Israel."
- Specifically, "Identifying as Muslim was <u>significantly associated</u> with being either hostile to Israel or hostile to Jews, even after controlling for other factors." Furthermore, compared to Christians, for example, Muslims were <u>2.6-fold</u> more likely to harbor the most virulent antisemitism, namely, shared hostility to both Israel and Jews.

Asking What Animates Such Intense Muslim Jew-Hatred Is Not A new Line of Inquiry: Thought Experiment (I)

Just prior to submitting the final manuscript of the first edition of *The Legacy of Islamic Antisemitism*, I took a brief hiatus and posed the following two questions, based upon my research, to a cadre of academics, independent scholars, theologians, journalists, activists—including a former Israeli Amb to the U.S.—who opine, in writing and speech, about Antisemitism, generally, and/or within the Muslim world, specifically. I asked (via e-mail correspondence),

"In your opinion, would this quote (below) exemplify racial, or at least ethnic Antisemitism? Moreover, would you please hazard a guess as to where and when it was written, based upon the contents?"

Here is the quote:

"Our people [the Muslims] observing thus the occupations of the Jews and the Christians concluded that the religion of the Jews must compare unfavorably as do their professions, and that their unbelief must be the foulest of all, since they are the filthiest of all nations. Why the Christians, ugly as they are, are physically less repulsive than the Jews may be explained by the fact that the Jews, by not intermarrying, have intensified the offensiveness of their features. Exotic elements have not mingled with them; neither have males of alien races had intercourse with their women, nor have their men cohabited with females of a foreign stock. The Jewish race therefore has been denied high mental qualities, sound physique, and superior lactation. The same results obtain when horses, camels, donkeys, and pigeons are inbred."

Asking What Animates Such Intense Muslim Jew-Hatred Is Not A New Line of Inquiry: Thought Experiment (II)

Not surprisingly, the replies of my correspondents reflected the conventional academic (and journalistic) wisdom which continues to assert Muslim Jew-hatred is only a recent phenomenon that began in the late 19th or early 20th centuries, & is a mere by-product of the advent of the Zionist movement, & the protracted Arab-Israeli conflict over the lands comprising the original 1922 Mandate for historical Palestine (i.e., modern Israel, Jordan, Judea, Samaria, and Gaza). Such thinking also contends that this strain of Jew hatred is a loose amalgam of re-cycled medieval Christian Judeophobic motifs, calumnies from the Czarist Russia "Protocols of the Elders of Zion," & standard European racist, or Fascist/Nazi propaganda. The contemporary pervasiveness of such flawed understanding was again manifested in the responses of my interlocutors

A representative sample of their comments demonstrates this phenomenon:

— "Of course it's Antisemitism, of the most vile racist stripe-which leads me to think it likely dates from the 19th century, at the earliest. It also sounds like the sort of thing one would read in the Antisemitic popular literature of the Edwardian period. So, my guess would be somewhere between 1830 and the 1920s."

- "I imagine this was written under the influence of modern theories of racial inferiority."
- "If I had to hazard a guess, I would say this is from a sermon in a Gaza mosque this past Friday..."
- —"Could be any mosque in the Muslim world, or Nazi Germany if it weren't for the first line. Definitely racial..."
- —"How about current (Saudi) Wahhabi establishment?"
- —"I have no idea who said it but I'll hazard a guess just for sport: the Mufti of Jerusalem, circa 1940?"
- —"Probably last week from one of the mullahs in the UK."

—"Yes, racist to the point of being Nazi-like. I would say, the Mufti of Jerusalem or some other Islamofascist, or maybe contemporary Wahhabi."

-"...it's the usual (modern) boiler plate from the Middle East."

Asking What Animates Such Intense Muslim Jew-Hatred Is Not A New Line of Inquiry: Thought Experiment (III)

The quote was written by the 9th century Iraqi Muslim polymath al-Jahiz (d. 869), contained within what was Jahiz's anti-Christian polemic commissioned by Caliph al-Mutawakkil (d. 861)

Caliph al-Mutawakkil understood, & al-Jahiz confirmed, that the mid-9th century Muslim masses harbored much more hostility toward the Jews than the Christians, which was disadvantageous vis-à-vis the threat of powerful bordering Christian kingdoms (Armenian; Byzantine)

al-Jahiz surmised that the primary reason for this Muslim animus toward the Jews was Quran 5:82 (and its classical interpretation in Islam's most authoritative Quranic commentaries*), & secondarily the "rancorous" interaction between Islam's prophet Muhammad, & the indigenous pre-Islamic Jews of Northern Arabia (as described, particularly, in the early traditions of Islam [hadith], & pious Muslim biographies of Muhammad [sira])

* al-Tabari's [d. 923] classical gloss on Quran **5:82**: *"In my opinion, [the Christians] are not like the Jews who always* scheme in order to murder the emissaries & the prophets (**2:61; 3:112**), & who oppose Allah in his positive & negative commandments (5:41-43), & who corrupt His scripture (2:79; 3:187) which He revealed in His books."

The basic contention in Al-Jahiz's essay that the Muslims harbored greater enmity towards the Jews than the Christians is supported by the independent observations of another Arab author active during the beginning of the 9th century in Iraq, the Sufi theologian al-Harith al-Muhasibi (d. 857). He maintained that because the Jews stubbornly denied Muhammad's truth, they were *"…in the eyes of the Muslims worse than the Christians."*

From Contemporary Polling Data, to Contemporary Animating Religious Ideology

1988 Hamas Charter/Covenant Features:

- First statement, even before the Preamble, is Qur'an 3:112, a sacred Islamic religious justification for the permanent degradation of the Jews (which became a feature of the Sharia, Islamic Law) because of their alleged "transgressions"
- Preamble extols the Muslim Brotherhood, & Hamas' connection to it
- Article 7 features a canonical tradition of Muhammad, where he claims the Jews must be annihilated to usher in the messianic age
- Article 15 summons the global Muslim community ("umma") to join Hamas in waging a jihad to destroy Israel as a political entity

Unique 2011 polling data by Stanley Greenberg et al querying agreement with these key elements of articles 7 & 15 in the Hamas Charter. 1,010 Palestinian Muslims in the West Bank & Gaza, were polled, face to face in Arabic.

Results:

- *"When given a quote from the Hamas Charter about the need for battalions from the Arab & Islamic world to defeat the Jews (Article 15), <u>80% agreed</u>."*
- "<u>73% agreed</u> with a quote from the charter (and a hadith, or tradition ascribed to the prophet Muhammad, in Article 7) about the need to kill Jews hiding behind stones and trees."

1956 Al-Azhar Fatwas

Issued by the Grand Imam & the heads of the 4 schools of Sunni Islamic jurisprudence Key overlapping extracts:

"Muslims cannot conclude peace with those Jews who have usurped the territory of Palestine & attacked its people & their property in any manner which allows the Jews to continue as a state in that sacred Muslim territory. [As] Jews have taken a part of Palestine and there established their non-Islamic government and have also evacuated from that part most of its Muslim inhabitants.... Jihad ... to restore the country to its people . . . is the duty of all Muslims, not just those who can undertake it. And since all Islamic countries constitute the abode of every Muslim, the Jihad is imperative for both the Muslims inhabiting the territory attacked, and Muslims everywhere else because even though some sections have not been attacked directly, the attack nevertheless took place on a part of the Muslim territory which is a legitimate residence for any Muslim... Everyone knows that from the early days of Islam to the present day the Jews have been plotting against Islam and Muslims and the Islamic homeland. They do not propose to be content with the attack they made on Palestine and AI Agsa Mosque, but they plan for the possession of all Islamic territories from the Nile to the Euphrates."

Note: Egypt then occupied Gaza, & Jordan occupied Judea-Samaria (the West Bank), nonetheless, these religious rulings maintained that all of historical Palestine—modern Jordan, Israel, & the disputed territories of Judea & Samaria, as well as Gaza having been conquered by jihad, was a permanent possession of the global Muslim umma (community), "fay territory"—booty or spoils—to be governed eternally by Islamic law.

1968 Al-Azhar Conference in the aftermath of the 1967 Six-Day War debacle

Assembled prominent Muslim theologians not only from the Middle East, but Asia, Africa, & Europe. This seminal, if ugly Conference, marked the formal abandonment of pseudo-secular "Arab Nationalism," in lieu of jihadism & Islamic Jew-hatred, as guiding ideological rationales for the simmering conflict with Israel.

6 key recurring themes, as summarized late historian, David Littman:

"Jews are frequently denoted as the 'Enemies of Allah'"
 "Jews manifest in themselves an historical continuity of evil qualities...as described in the Qur'an"
 "The Jews do not constitute a true people or nation"
 "The State of Israel is the culmination of the historical and cultural depravity of the Jews...It has to be destroyed by a Jihad"
 "The superiority of Islam over all other religions is brandished as a guarantee that the Arabs will ultimately triumph"
 "It is outrageous for the Jews, traditionally kept by Arab Islam in a humiliated, inferior status, and characterized as cowardly, to defeat the Arabs, have their own State, and cause the contraction of the 'abode of Islam""

Littman's analysis of the 935 pp. Conference Proceedings in 1971, concluded Al Azhar was promoting ideas which,


"lead to the urge to liquidate Israel, politicide, & the Jews, genocide. If the evil of the Jews is immutable & permanent, transcending time and circumstances, & impervious to all hopes of reform, there is only one way to cleanse the world of them—by their complete annihilation."

THE MOST Authoritative Modern Sunni Islamic Cleric Promoted "Sacralized" Islamic Antisemitism, & Global Jihad Against Israel (I)

Al-Azhar University, Sunni Papal equivalent Grand Imam, Muhammad Tantawi (1996 to d. 2010), & arguably the most important modern Sunni Quranic commentator

- As Grand Imam, Tantawi, in April 2002, referred to Israeli Jews, as "enemies of Allah, descendants of apes and pigs." (Qur'an 5:60; Jews as "apes," alone, in Qur'an 2:65 & 7:166)
- That same month, he sanctioned homicide bombing "martyrdom" operations against "any Israeli, including children, women, and teenagers," notwithstanding the gruesome Netanya Passover homicide bomber massacre just beforehand, on March 27, 2002.



THE MOST Authoritative Modern Sunni Islamic Cleric Promoted "Sacralized" Islamic Antisemitism, & Global Jihad Against Israel (II)

From Tantawi's 1968, "Jews in the Qur'an & Traditions":

"(The) Qur'an describes the Jews with their own particular" degenerate characteristics, i.e. killing the prophets of Allah (see Qur'an 2:61/3:112], corrupting His words by putting them in the wrong places (4:46), consuming the people's wealth frivolously (4:161), refusal to distance themselves from the evil they do (3:120; 5:79), and other ugly characteristics caused by their deep-rooted (lascivious) envy (2:109)...only a minority of the Jews keep their word...[A] Jews are not the same. The good ones become Muslims (Qur'an 3:113), the bad ones do not...[T]he Jews always remain maleficent deniers....they should desist from their negative denial...some Jews went way overboard in their denying hostility, so gentle persuasion can do no good with them, so use force with them and treat them in the way you see as effective in ridding them of their evil. One may go so far as to ban their religion, their persons, their wealth, and their villages."

From Tantawi's 1992, "The Broad Interpretation of the Holy Qur'an":

Tantawi on Qur'an 5:60 (which dubs the Jews "apes and pigs") condemned in broad terms, *"the corrupt thinking and false assumptions and claims of the Jews...what you [the Jews] claim is even more evil as shown in the penalty that has befallen you as you have been cursed and become estranged from Allah's mercy and compassion, and what has befallen your ancestors, of whom some were transformed into apes, others into pigs."*

Tantawi on Qur'an 9:29, timeless declaration of jihad war on Jews (& Christians) refusing to submit to Islamic Law, paying tribute, & being servile: "The reasons for the order to fight them are: they do not believe in Allah & the Last Day, they do not prohibit what Allah and His Messenger [Muhammad] have prohibited, and they do not adopt the religion of truth (Islam)...The meaning is fight those who have these attributes from among the People of the Scripture until they pay the Jizya willingly and submissively (while) they are humbled, humiliated and subservient to your rule over them...Taking the Jizya (Quranic poll tax) from them...is also a way of contributing to the advancement and prosperity of the Islamic state....It is an acknowledgement on their behalf to submit to the instructions of this state...Those who do not adopt the religion of truth [i.e., Islam] as their religion, deserve humiliation and ignominy in this world. As for the afterlife, their torture would be excruciatingly painful and everlasting."

Current (since 2010) Al-Azhar University Grand Imam al-Tayeb

Ahmad al-Tayeb, former mufti of Egypt, Al-Azhar President, & since 2010, Grand Imam of Al-Azhar.

- Sanctioned homicide bombing against all Israeli Jews in 2007
- Claimed in 2014 & 2018 the internecine strife in the Muslim world caused by ISIS & other jihad terror groups, was a Zionist plot
- In 2018 he further insisted the "Zionist entity" will "march on the Kaaba [central stone structure in Islam's holy mosque in Mecca] & on the Prophet's mosque [in Medina]. This is on their minds & in their hearts."
- Nonetheless, he also stated in 2018, "the issue of antisemitism is a lie that continues to deceive nations to this day."



Tayeb, during 2013 & 2017 Egyptian national television interviews, rationalized permanent Muslim hatred of Jews by riveting on Qur'an 5:82, which epitomized an alleged 1400 years of Muslim "suffering from Jewish and Zionist interference." From his 2013 interview:

"A verse in the Qur'an explains the Muslims' relations with the Jews...This is an historical perspective, which has not changed to this day. See how we suffer today from global Zionism and Judaism...Since the inception of Islam 1,400 years ago, we have been suffering from Jewish and Zionist interference in Muslim affairs. This is a cause of great distress for the Muslims. The Qur'an said it and history has proven it: 'You shall find the strongest among men in enmity to the believers to be the Jews'..."

What about this and that? **'They killed the prophets unjustly.' 'That is because they disobeyed [Allah] and transgressed.**' (**Quran 2:61; 3:112**) "In another verse, Allah was addressing them, saying: **'Then your heart became hardened after that, being like stones or even harder.' (Quran 2:74)** Their hearts are harder than stone. They have no hearts. They have no humanity. The have no trust. **'Every time they make a covenant, a group of them casts it aside. In fact, most of them do not believe.' (Quran 2:100)** "You cannot trust their promises or their agreements. 'They hear the words of Allah and then distort it.' (**Quran 2:75**) 'They will not stop fighting you until they turn you back from your faith if they can.' (**Quran 2:217**) They do everything [so] that you forget about your principles and values, and just give up. That is... "But Allah says: 'They will not fight you all, except within fortified cities or from behind walls.' (**Quran 59:14**) They are not coming directly. Mainstream Islamic Jew-Hatred Preached From U.S. Mosques Post-October 7th, Example 2

Imam Umar Mitchell of Masjid Umar Ibn Al-Khattab in Aurora, Colorado taught a Qur'anic lesson to children at the Colorado Muslims Community Center, October 22, 2023, outlining for his young audience central indelible, pejorative characteristics of the Jews as depicted in the Qur'an:

- He intoned that the Jews are inveterate liars (Qur'an 2:10; 3:75) who never abide their contracts and covenants (2:61; 3:112; 4:155; 5:13), murdered their prophets (2:61; 3:112; 3:181; 4:155), and even attempted to murder Jesus (actually "Isa," a decidedly non-Christian "Muslim Jesus," 4:157).
- Imam Mitchell also recounted the Qur'anic story of Jewish fishermen who were allegedly transformed by Allah into "literal physical monkeys" for fishing on Saturday (2:65; but elaborated in 7:163, 7:164; 7;165; 7:166; verse 5:60 refers to the Jews as "apes and pigs").
- Imam Mitchell concluded that not all Jews are as despicable as their portrayal in the Qur'an but consistent with Qur'an 3:113, he asserted only "a couple of them" aren't.
- Imam Mitchell garnered the following predictable responses from his "successfully" indoctrinated young audience:

[Mitchell] "So I'm going to ask you: If this is the group of people who broke their rules with Allah, should you trust these people today?"[Children]: "No!"

[Mitchell]: "Does this sound like good worshippers?" [Children]: "No!"

[Mitchell]: "He (Allah) made them into monkeys. Literal physical monkeys. Monkeys. Does this sound like a people you want to do business with?" [Children]: "No!

Summary Evaluation of Hundreds of U.S. Mosque Sermons After 10/7/23

Mansour Al-Hadj is the Muslim Director of the Middle East Research Institute Project for Reform in the Arab and Muslim World. After studying "hundreds of Friday mosque sermons" across the U.S. after October 7, 2023, he acknowledged,

..."almost all the sermons seemed to share similar themes in their framing of the attack, <u>amplifying</u> <u>a single narrative which justifies Hamas's attack as a legitimate act that is based on the command</u> <u>of Allah and the teachings of the prophet Muhammad</u>. Therefore, they did not condemn or hold Hamas responsible for killing and abducting civilians, including children and the elderly, and sexually assaulting women. Instead, in their sermons, these preachers and imams focused on highlighting the similarities between Hamas' attack and the wars fought by the prophet and his companions, demonizing Israel, narrating historical antisemitic stories attributed to the prophet Muhammad, founder of Islam, such as the hadith about the stones and the Gharqad Tree, and citing verses from the Qur'an that characterized Jews as corrupt, treacherous, untrustworthy, and the killers of prophets."





ADL Repeatedly Ignores, or Downplays, the Disproportionate Muslim Antisemitism Revealed by its Own Surveys (III)

Salient examples 2-5, from W. Europe & the U.S., 2015-2023

2015—rates were *"lower than corresponding figures of 75% in 2014 for Muslims in the Middle East and North Africa."*

2017—ignoring the 2.4-fold excess rate of extreme Muslim Antisemitism among American Muslims, i.e., 34%, relative to 14% in American non-Muslims—consistent with global patterns ADL has detected for at least the past decade—the report <u>chirped</u>, *"that is far lower than Muslims in Europe, where 55% hold these views, and the Middle East/North Africa, where 75% hold (extreme) Antisemitic views."*

2019—listing the Muslim data as the <u>last</u> of six bullet points—ADL grudgingly acknowledged, "Muslim acceptance of Antisemitic stereotypes was substantially higher than among the national populations—on average almost three times as high—in the six countries tested: Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Spain, and The United Kingdom." ADL also failed to note how compared to Western European Christians, specifically, Muslims remained three times more likely to harbor extreme Antisemitic attitudes.
2023—ADL's 22pp. summary report of its most recent survey of 6 Western and 4 Eastern European countries (published May, 2023), makes no mention whatsoever of extreme Muslim Antisemitism, while emphasizing (p.17) alleged, "high concern over right wing violence."

Palestinian Muslim Attitudes Toward Hamas, Just Before, & After, October 7, 2023

- Palestinian <u>polling data</u> obtained by the <u>Palestinian Center for Policy and Survey Research</u>, (PCPSR) Bir Zeit University, Research from face-to-face interviews of 1270 adults, obtained June 7th to 11th, 2023, confirmed the public preference for Hamas over Fatah: Hamas polled 10% higher than Fatah on the question of "deserving to represent the people," while Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh was preferred by 23% more Palestinians than Fatah leader Mahmoud Abbas, to be President.
- Released Nov. 14, 2023, 668 Palestinians polled (391 West Bank; 277 Gaza) by <u>Arab World for Research & Development</u>: "How much do support the military operation carried out by the Palestinian <u>resistance</u> led by Hamas?" 75% extremely or somewhat supportive, 59.3% extremely; 15.7% somewhat. Also reported these "favorability's": Hamas 76%, but Palestinian Authority only 10%; Highest favorability among designated military/jihad terror organizations: Al Qassam Brigades 89%; Islamic Jihad 84%; Al Aqsa Brigades 80%
- PCPSR poll released Dec 13, 2023, n=1231 adults interviewed face to face 750 West Bank /481 in Gaza Strip: 72% (82% in the West Bank/57% in Gaza) said Oct 7th jihadist attack was "correct decision". Satisfaction with the role of Hamas was the highest—72%; (85% West Bank/ 52% Gaza) followed by the role played by Hamas leader Sinwar 69% (81% West Bank/ 52% Gaza), vs. only 14% for the PA (10% West Bank/21% Gaza), & 11% for PA/Fatah leader Mahmoud Abbas (7% West Bank/ 17% Gaza). 54% believed that Hamas is the most deserving of representing & leading the Palestinian people, while 13% believed that Fatah under the leadership of Abbas is more deserving. For the Arab regional actors, the highest level of satisfaction went to Houthi-dominated Yemen 80% (89% West Bank/ 68% Gaza), followed by Qatar, 56%.




<u>Shiite Islam (~10% of Muslims)</u>: "Theosopher" and pre-eminent modern Shiite Quranic commentator, Muhammad Tabatabai (d. 1981), after whom the Islamic Republic of Iran's largest specialized social sciences university is named

Tabatabai's gloss on Qur'an 5:82:

"...the Jews, they had their own scholars, no doubt; but they behaved proudly, and their arrogance and stubbornness did not let them be prepared for accepting the truth...Jews, although they had the same alternatives as the Christians, and they could retain their religion with payment of the jizya [Qur'anic poll tax, per verse 9:29], yet they continued in their haughtiness, became harder in their bigotry, and turned to double dealing and deception. They broke their covenants, eagerly waited calamities to befall the Muslims and dealt to them the bitterest deal...[T]he enmity of the Jews...toward the divine religion [Islam] and their sustained arrogance and bigotry, have continued exactly in the same manner even after the Prophet... These unchanged characteristics confirm what the Mighty Book [the Qur'an] had indicated." Tabatabai's general description beginning at Qur'an 2:40 to 2:44, & continuing for over a 100 verses thereafter:

"Now begins the rebuking of the Jews that continues for more than a hundred verses. Allah reminds them of the bounties bestowed, of the honors given; contrasting it with their ingratitude and disobedience; showing how at every juncture they paid the favors of Allah with disregard of their covenant, open rebellion against divine commands and even with polytheism. The series reminds them of twelve events of their history — ... all of which shows how they were chosen to receive the especial favors of Allah. But their ingratitude runs parallel to it. They repeatedly broke the covenants made with Allah, committed capital sins, heinous crimes, and shameful deeds; more despicable was their spiritual poverty and moral bankruptcy — in open defiance to their book and total disregard for reason. It was all because their hearts were hardened, their souls lost and their endeavors worthless."

Tabatabai on Quran 9:29:

"Regarding their characteristics that necessitate fighting them, as mentioned in the beginning of the verse, followed by them giving the jizya to uphold their protection [i.e., from renewal of the jihad war against them!], it informs [us] that the purpose of humiliating them is their submission to an Islamic lifestyle and to a righteous religious government within an Islamic society. They shall not be equal to Muslims nor stand out against with them as an independent identity, free to express anything their souls feel like, nor to publicize the doctrines and activities invented by their lunacies that corrupt human societies. This all relates to them handing over money from their hands out of a contemptible position. So the meaning of the verse (and Allah knows best) is: Fight the People of the Book who do not [truly] believe in Allah or in the Last Day, with a faith that is acceptable and uncorrupted from being proper, and who do not forbid what is forbidden in Islam namely those [crimes] that, when committed, corrupt human society, and who do not abide by a religion that conforms with the divine creation. Fight them and persist in fighting them until they are humbled among you, and submit to your rule."

Genocidal Jew-Hate Openly Preached at a Kansas City Mosque, 11/15/24

In his November 15, 2024 Friday sermon at the Kansas City Islamic Center (uploaded to its YouTube channel) Imam Muhammad Tarife said that the Islamic nation is the "best nation"(Quran 3:110) and that it was brought to the world in order to encourage others to do good. However, to conclude his sermon, he begged Allah (in Arabic):

"Oh, Allah, annihilate the criminal Zionists – those of whom are Zionists and those who are not. Oh, Allah, count them, kill them one by one, and do not spare a single one of them, for they are no match for You. Oh, Allah, allow us torment them with our own hands, humiliate them, grant us victory over them, and heal the hearts of the believers (i.e., Muslims)."

They will all be killed, this is a divine promise that will inevitably be fulfilled. This is a promise from Allah and it is going to happen. They will all be killed. They will all be killed, and on that day, the believers will rejoice in Allah's victory."
